

Ata Sarajedini is currently the Bjorn Lamborn Endowed Chair in Astrophysics at Florida Atlantic University (FAU). He served as Dean of the Charles E. Schmidt College of Science between 2017 and 2020. Before that, he served as Associate Dean at the University of Florida. He earned his Ph.D. in Astronomy at Yale and was awarded a Hubble Fellowship, an NSF CAREER award, and a University of Florida Research Professor award. Dr. Sarajedini has over 500 publications, which have over 16,000 citations. Of these publications, over 200 have appeared in the peer-reviewed literature. His research area is focused on studying how galaxies form by studying their resolved stellar populations.
