

“New Discoveries from the James Webb Space Telescope Three Years After Launch”

The James Webb Space Telescope was launched December 2021 and began taking scientific observations in June 2022. Now, three years after science observations have begun, JWST has made significant contributions to our knowledge in a range of areas from planetary science to cosmology.
